**THE MAHARASHTRA PROHIBITION OF RAGGING ACT, 1999.**

<b><i>Prohibition of Ragging</i></b>	Ragging within or outside of any educational Institution is prohibited.
<b><i>Definitions</i></b>	“Ragging” means display of disorderly conduct doing of any act which causes or is likely to cause physical or psychological harm or raise apprehension or fear or shame or embarrassment to a student in any educational institution and includes – i. Teasing, abusing, threatening or playing practical jokes on or causing hurt to such students or ii. Asking a student to do any act or perform something which such student will not in the ordinary course willingly do.
<b><i>Penalty for Ragging</i></b>	Whoever directly or indirectly commits participates in abets or propagates ragging within or outside any educational institution shall on conviction be <b><u>punished</u></b> with <b><u>imprisonment</u></b> for a term which may extend to <b><u>two years</u></b> and shall also be liable to a fine which may extent <b><u>to ten thousand rupees.</u></b>
<b><i>Dismissal of Student</i></b>	Any student convicted on an offence under section 4 shall be <b><u>dismissed</u></b> from the educational institution and such student shall not be admitted in any other educational institution for a period of <b><u>Five years</u></b> from the date of order of such dismissal.

*All the students of this Institution are notified and instructed not to get involved in act of ragging, otherwise they will be punished as per the provisions of “THE PROHIBITION OF RAGGING ACT, 1999”.*
