

Liberal learning.

The general philosophy and guidelines are as below:

- The subject would be for one credit only.
- This credit would be over and above, however it will be considered for the computation of SGA/CGA.
- Minimum student strength required for a subject to be offered will be ten.
- There will not be any formal teaching offered by institute.
- An expert would be nominated. He may visit institute once in a month.
- The scope and learning requirements of the subject would be discussed by the expert with students directly and would also be available on the website.
- Students would learn about the subject on their own and discuss or get help from expert during his monthly visit.
- The evaluation criteria would be finalized by the expert and declared well in advance
- Expert himself would carry out evaluation and award grades at the end of semester
- A nominal fee would be offered in the beginning
- This scheme would be separate than Audit and elective courses
- The guidelines are subject to change and would be notified every year by Academic cell
