

## Students Innovative Projects

Students innovative projects following are the brief guidelines.

1. It can be Interdisciplinary
2. Financial support maximum up to Rs. one lakh (inclusive of everything like fabrication setup, travel, etc)
3. Four UG and one PG project (normal situation)
4. One mentor per project (he would have full authority)
5. Mentor to be asked/suggested by student
6. Patents highly encouraged
7. Patent rights would be exclusively with institute.
8. Student and mentor names would be involved in patent and commercial aspects can be decided case to case basis.
9. Institute to help for patent filing
10. Minimum three and maximum six students (no gender difference)
11. Maximum one student from each department will be allowed
12. One student can participate in one project only
13. Project would be in addition with regular project
14. Any student from second year to final year can participate
15. Project must be completed within one year
16. Team to decide their leader who would be responsible for all records, expenditure, reports, etc.
17. Team would get opportunity to present the project before BOG
18. Students can discuss with professors for ideas
19. Screening and selection to be done by Hon. Shri Kamlesh Pande, Ram Bhogle & Director – SGGSI&T.
20. Quarterly review would be taken by above members
21. Presentations to be done by participants as below (Ten minutes):
  - a. About seven slides
  - b. Title with team member names
  - c. Brief description (2 slides)
  - d. Justification and expected outcome (1 slide)
  - e. Novelty and practical utility (1 slide)
  - f. Approximate budget (1 slide)
  - g. Bar chart for completion (1 slide)
  - h. Work allocation (1 slide)
  - i. Ten minutes presentation followed by about ten minutes of Q/A
